2. How will the growing need to switch to second line regimens impact markets and public health?
3. How the increased coverage of PMTCT will affect the pediatric ARV market and forecasting?
4. Further analysis of the risks of transitioning in 2012.
5. How commodity costs will be revised during the procurement process and how they might affect the budget.
