



## Resolution n° 11-2018-e

### **Expanding the use of TRIPS flexibilities to promote affordable access to medicines**

Recalling Unitaid Board Resolution UNITAID/2017/R22-e in which the Board provided its go-ahead for the development by the Unitaid Secretariat of a full draft grant agreement package for the proposed Project “Expanding the use of TRIPS flexibilities to promote affordable access to medicines” submitted by the South Centre (“the Project”);

and

Noting the alignment of this Project with the Board approved Area for Intervention: “Supporting the use of TRIPS flexibilities”;

The Board authorizes, subject to availability of funds, the Executive Director to commit up to USD 6,886,981 for the Project.

Funding is conditional upon signature of the grant agreement between Unitaid and South Centre.

Lead Organization: South Centre

Target countries: UMIC: Brazil, Ecuador, Paraguay, Peru, South Africa and LMIC: Angola, India, Indonesia, Morocco, Sri Lanka

Project Duration: 36 months (3 years) from 1 July 2018.
