

## Resolution n°15-2016-e

A randomised trial to compare dolutegravir+darunavir/r versus recommended standard of care antiretroviral regimens in patients with HIV infection who have failed recommended first line therapy

Recalling Resolution n°3-2015-e, in which the UNITAID Board provided its go-ahead for the development by the UNITAID Secretariat of a full draft grant agreement package for the proposed Project "A randomised trial to compare dolutegravir+darunavir/r versus recommended standard of care antiretroviral regimens in patients with HIV infection who have failed recommended first line therapy" submitted by The University of New South Wales through the Kirby Institute; and

Noting the alignment of the Project with the Board-approved Area for Intervention: 'Improving Adult Antiretroviral Therapy in Low and Middle-income Countries: Providing Support for Evidence-gathering on the Use of New Priority Antiretroviral Regimens for First and Second-line Therapy';

The Board authorizes, subject to availability of funds, the Executive Director to commit up to US\$ 8,806,936 for the Project.

Funding is conditional upon signature of the draft grant agreement between UNITAID and The University of New South Wales.
