



Resolution n° 19-2018-e

Go-ahead for the development of grant agreement packages on better tools for integrated management of childhood fever for proposed projects with PATH and ALIMA

With reference to the Area for Intervention: **“Better tools for integrated management of childhood fever”**, as approved by the Executive Board in Resolution EB28/2017/R5; and

Taking into account the project proposal assessments by the Joint Review Committee, the Executive Board authorizes the Secretariat to *go-ahead* with the development into draft grant agreement packages for subsequent submission to and approval by the Board, of the following proposed projects:

1. Data for Fever Management (DFM): Market strengthening and scale-up for point-of-care devices to improve patient outcomes (PATH)
2. OPTIFARE : OPTimisation de l'Identification des Fièvres A Risque chez l'Enfant (ALIMA)

The Board recalls that, in accordance with Resolution EB22/2015/R3, the Secretariat may now use the Project Preparation Facility to support the effective development of the grant agreement packages for these proposals. This decision has no other funding implications.
