

Resolution n°1-2019-e

Accelerating Demand for HIV Self-Testing through a Human Centered Design Challenge Fund and Campaign

Recalling Unitaid Board Resolution 13-2018-e in which the Board provided its go-ahead for the development by the Unitaid Secretariat of a co-funding agreement with the Elton John AIDS Foundation (EJAF), for an amount of up to USD 1,500,000, to co-finance the Project entitled "Accelerating Demand for HIV Self-Testing through a Human Centered Design Challenge Fund and Campaign" together with EJAF and the Children's Investment Fund Foundation (CIFF) (the "Project"); and

Noting the alignment of the Project with the Board approved Area for Intervention: "Expanding access to HIV self-testing in low and middle income countries (LMICs)";

The Board authorizes, subject to availability of funds, the Executive Director to commit up to USD 1,500,000 for the Project.

Funding is conditional upon signature of the grant agreement between Unitaid and EJAF.
