



Resolution n°28-2021-e

Cost Extension for the Project ‘Preparedness for the Rollout of Effective HIV Prevention among Key Affected Populations in Brazil, Peru and Mexico’

Recalling Unitaid Board Resolution n° 7-2017-e in which the Board authorized, subject to availability of funds, the Executive Director to commit an amount of up to US\$ 26,355,192 for the project entitled ‘Preparedness for the Rollout of Effective HIV Prevention among Key Affected Populations in Brazil, Peru and Mexico’ (the “Project”), to be implemented by Fundação para o Desenvolvimento Científico e Tecnológico em Saúde (“FIOTEC”) during a 3-year period ending on 30 June 2020;

Noting that during 2020, the Secretariat approved a 12-month no-cost extension to the duration of funding for the Project, ending 30 June 2021;

Recalling Unitaid Board Resolution n° 2-2021-e in which the Board authorized a further 6-month no-cost extension to the duration of funding for the Project, ending on 31 December 2021;

Taking into account the assessment by the PRC and the Secretariat’s recommendations, the Board authorizes the Executive Director, subject to the availability of funds, to commit additional funding of up to US\$ 9,869,701 for the Project and to extend the duration of funding for the Project by a further 3 years up to 31 December 2024.

The additional funding and the extension to the Project duration shall not apply to the new COVID-19 related Outputs and are conditional upon signature of formal amendment to the grant agreement for the Project.
