UNITAID Civil Society Engagement

The Executive Board takes note of the important role that Civil Society can have in contributing to project achievements, including information sharing at country level, demand creation and providing feedback on how tools and services affect access to those living with and affected by the three diseases.

The Board requests that the Secretariat encourages Proponents to include, where appropriate, engagement with Civil Society in order to achieve increase uptake of commodities at country level. The Secretariat will report activities and achievements on a regular basis to the PSC/Board.

The Board requests that Secretariat explore further opportunities to engage existing Civil Society networks, including those set up by partners such as the Global Fund, GAVI Alliance among others.
