



Resolution n°30-2021-e

Malaria Vaccine Pilot Implementation Program – Phase 2

Recalling Executive Board Resolution R11-2016-e, in which the Board provided its go-ahead for the development by the Secretariat of a full draft grant agreement package for an amount up to USD 13.2 million for the project entitled “**RTS,s/AS01 Pilot implementation Programme**” (“**the Project**”);

Noting that under Resolution R11-2016-e, the Executive Director was authorised to commit an initial amount of USD 9.6 million to the World Health Organization (WHO) for Phase 1 of the Project, with the balance of USD 3.6 million for Phase 2 of the Project remaining subject to subsequent approval of the Board, based on the Secretariat’s analysis and evaluation of the Project;

Acknowledging the analysis and satisfactory evaluation of the Project by the Secretariat, as well as the decisions of The Global Fund and Gavi to commit their shares of co-funding to WHO for Phase 2; and

Noting the recommendation of the Secretariat to release Unitaid’s share of the co-funding for Phase 2 of the Project on this basis, the Executive Board now authorises the Executive Director to commit up to a further USD 3.6 million for Phase 2 of the Project. Funding is conditional upon the signature of an agreement between Unitaid and WHO.
