Accelerating Demand for HIV Self-Testing (HIVST) Among Young People

Recalling Unitaid Board Resolution UNITAID/2017/R10-e in which the Board provided its go-ahead for the development by the Unitaid Secretariat of a full draft grant agreement package for the proposed Project “Accelerating Demand for HIV Self-Testing (HIVST) Among Young People” submitted by the MTV Staying Alive Foundation (“the Project”); and

Noting the alignment of this Project with the Board approved Area for Intervention: “Expanding Access to HIV self-testing in low and middle income countries (LMICs)”;

The Board authorizes, subject to availability of funds, the Executive Director to commit up to USD 10,074,243 for the Project.

Funding is conditional upon signature of the grant agreement between Unitaid and MTV Staying Alive Foundation.
