Health for all: Increasing access to HIV, TB and Hepatitis C treatment through effective use of TRIPS flexibilities

Recalling Unitaid Board Resolution Unitaid/2017/R22-e in which the Board provided its go-ahead for the development by the Unitaid Secretariat of a full draft grant agreement package for the proposed Project 'Health for all: Increasing access to HIV, TB and Hepatitis C treatment through effective use of TRIPS flexibilities' submitted by the Third World Network ("the Project"); and

Noting the alignment of this Project with the Board approved Area for Intervention: "Supporting the use of TRIPS flexibilities";

The Board authorizes, subject to availability of funds, the Executive Director to commit up to USD 4,899,620 for the Project.

Funding is conditional upon signature of the grant agreement between Unitaid and Third World Network.

Lead Organization: Third World Network Berhad

Target Countries: Bangladesh, Burkina Faso, China, Egypt, India, Indonesia, Malaysia, Nepal, Philippines, Senegal.

Project Duration: 42 months (3.5 years)
