"Preventing Deaths from Cervical Cancer by Catalysing the use of Optimal Screening Tests and Treatment Devices" Project

Recalling Unitaid Executive Board Resolution n°18-2018-e of 23 November 2018, in which the Board provided its go-ahead for the development by the Unitaid Secretariat of a full grant agreement package for the proposed project *Preventing Deaths from Cervical Cancer by Catalysing the use of Optimal Screening Tests and Treatment Devices* (the "Project")

The Executive Board now authorizes the Secretariat to commit up to USD 32,958,435 for the Project, subject to availability of funds.

Funding is conditional upon signature of the grant agreement between Unitaid and the Clinton Health Access Initiative (CHAI).
