UNLOCKING THE HEPATITIS C DIAGNOSTICS AND TREATMENT MARKET

Recalling UNITAID Board Resolution n°3-2015-e, in which the Board provided its go-ahead for the development by the UNITAID Secretariat of a full draft grant agreement package for the proposed Project “*Unlocking the Hepatitis C diagnostic and treatment market*” (“the Project”) submitted by the Foundation for Innovative New Diagnostics (FIND);

and

Noting the alignment of this Project with the Board-approved Area for Intervention: ‘Development of better tools to diagnose HCV, in particular in case of HIV/HCV co-infection’;

The Board authorizes, subject to availability of funds, the Executive Director to commit up to **USD 38,264,301** for the Project.

Funding is conditional upon signature of the draft grant agreement between UNITAID and FIND.

Target Countries: Cameroon, Georgia, India, Malaysia, Myanmar, Thailand, Vietnam

Project Duration: 3,5 years
