**Resolution n°1
Tuberculosis Strategic Orientation**

The Board of UNITAID accepts the strategic orientation for Tuberculosis proposed by the Secretariat as an interim strategy recognising that the Tuberculosis landscape is evolving, namely:

- **Strategic orientation for 1st line TB:** Maintain the current action with GDF to provide transitional funding to selected countries and invest in a strategic stockpile of drugs and seek to transition out of this action in 2009 as planned. In parallel, explore possible targeted interventions to stabilise the API market.
- **Strategic orientation for pediatric TB:** Maintain the current action with GDF to ensure development, prequalification and rapid scale-up of pediatric TB drugs and seek to transition out of this action in 2010 as planned.
- **Strategic orientation for MDR-TB:** Maintain the current action with Global Fund, GDF and GLC until 2011 while investigating options to further reduce lead times, publicly commit to fund further scale-up of treatment as more patients are diagnosed. Develop a model to facilitate rapid scale-up of current and emerging diagnostic technologies.
